Therefore the College itself will conduct Faculty Development Program, Training Programs, Workshops etc. for teaching as well as nonteaching members in batches. Members will also be encouraged to sharpen them joining such programs outside and the College may support them.
- 9. We wish to give exposure and equal weight age to our students so we are planning to nominate Brand Ambassadors in different categories in this session to serve and pay attention in a better way and to have our students' cooperation in various activities.
- 10. We shall provide Counselling and Guidance not only for academics but also to enrich their knowledge in various fields such as financial awareness, social and psychological security, legal rights, placement opportunities etc.
- 11. Efforts will be made to ensure the availability of support system such as wheel chairs, Enotice board (Brail) etc. to those who need it.
- 12. To encourage faculty for e content development
- 13. For socio economic growth of girls /women, a Women Study Centre is planned to be established where rural women empowerment, Counselling and Guidance for awareness programs on government schemes, psychological, social counselling, different trainings

related to women empowerment etc. will be held. ICT based trainings will also be provided.

- 14. To maintain green and eco friendly campus activities like Environmental impact assessment, Environmental Audit will be done. Alumni association will be strengthen.
- 15. To develop the sense of responsibility towards society in our girls, to help people from nearby villages, program **DARPAN** will be launched in which village **Barai** near Gwalior will be adopted where Orientation /Training programs will be held for ICT awareness, financial schemes, rural development schemes, Causes and Cures of malnutrition in Children, empowering women with ICT etc.
- 16. For internal administration of the College installation of M.I.S. Software is in the process.
- 17. Some departments, science block, academic cell, placement cell etc. will be extended, medicinal herbal garden will be developed and sport infrastructure will also be extended. Renovation work will also be done in some departments
- 18. A separate building for Law studies is in progress which will be completed in this year.

#### **History**

Founded in 1937, Govt. Kamla Raja Girls Post Graduate Autonomous College, Gwalior, is a pioneer and premier institution for women in higher education in this part of country. It was elevated to the post graduate level in 1970 and autonomous status was conferred on it in 1995. Standing with majestic grace in the heart of the city, the College is housed in one of the palaces of the erstwhile Scindhia dynasty. It has an impressive historic main building, Saraswati Mahal alternated by lush green lawns, tall trees and blocks of various faculties constructed lately. It is a unique College of old and new architecture as well as picturesque natural beauty spread over a vast campus of 53714.60 sq. m.

National Assessment & Accreditation council, Banglore (NAAC) has accredited this college as B level (equivalent to previous \* \* \* \* grade) among autonomous colleges in 2002. During reaccreditation process by NAAC in 2010, college has accredited by B grade. In the third cycle of NAAC reaccreditation, college has been upgraded as **A** grade College in 2016.


